



**2008 NATIONAL GC CPGA SENIOR SCRAMBLE**  
**The National Golf Club – Pinehurst, NC**  
**Tuesday – Wednesday, December 9-10, 2008**

- ENTRY FEE** \$260.00 per team (*\$130.00 per player*) payable to the Carolinas PGA Section (*cart/range fee for the tournament rounds are included in the entry fee*). Entry fee must accompany the official entry form and be payable by check, debit card, or credit card (Visa or Master Card Only).
- ENTRY DEADLINE** The field is limited to the first 64 entry forms received by the Carolinas PGA. Entries must reach the CPGA Headquarters by **5:00 PM on Tuesday, November 25**. Entries received after the entry deadline will be placed on a waiting list according to the order they are received. Applications not completed in full will not be accepted and returned immediately. Faxed entry forms are acceptable. Telephone or email entries will not be accepted.
- ONLINE ENTRY** All contestants have the option to register online. Visit <http://www.Carolinas.PGA.com>, click the "Tournament Info" page, and select this tournament. Anyone having any questions regarding online registration should contact Carolinas PGA headquarters at (843) 399-2742.
- ELIGIBILITY** **Professionals** – CPGA Professionals, in good standing, 50 years of age or older as of December 9.  
**Amateurs** – Members of the 2008 CPGA Senior Associate Program, 50 years of age or older as of December 9.

- PRACTICE ROUNDS** Monday, December 8 is the official practice round. Call the club to make practice round arrangements. A cart fee of \$20.00 will be charged for all contestants.
- FORMAT** **36-Hole 2-Person Captain's Choice** (scramble). Any tie for the tournament championship will be settled by a sudden-death playoff immediately after the conclusion of the final round. All other ties will share equally. This tournament is not an official 2008 Carolinas PGA Senior Player of the Year points event.
- RULES OF GOLF** Play shall be governed in accordance with the 2008-09 Rules of Golf of the United States Golf Association, as modified by the Carolinas PGA Rules of Play card and supplemented by the Notice to Competitors. Questions or disputes shall be settled by the Rules Committee, whose decision is final.
- DISTANCE-MEASURING DEVICES** In all Carolinas PGA sanctioned events, a player may obtain distance information by using a device that measures distance only. However, if, during a stipulated round, a player uses a distance-measuring device that is designed to gauge or measure other conditions that might affect his play (e.g., gradient, wind-speed, temperature, etc.), the player is in breach of Rule 14-3, for which the penalty is disqualification, regardless of whether any such additional functions are actually used.
- DIVISIONS** Professionals and amateurs will be permitted to play on the same team. Teams will be placed into age divisions based on adding the two partners' ages together and dividing that number in half. The following age divisions will be used: Championship Tees: 50-54, 55-59, 60-64. Super Senior Tees: 65 & up. Both partners must play from the same set of tees (i.e. if a team's average age places them in the 60-64 age division but one of the players on the team is over the age 65, he must play from the Championship Tees). Anyone having questions regarding the age division structure should contact the Carolinas PGA at (843) 399-2742.  
**\*\*\*The CPGA reserves the right to adjust any and all age divisions to balance the field.**
- CONFIRMATIONS** Confirmations will be mailed on Wednesday, November 26. First round starting times will be emailed on Friday, December 5 and made available at <http://Carolinas.PGA.com>.
- WITHDRAWALS** In order to receive a full refund all withdrawals must be received by **5:00 PM on Sunday, December 7**. - FOOTWEAR** It is a condition of competition that shoes with traditionally designed spikes or metal spikes are prohibited from being worn for play.
- CADDIES** Caddies are permitted for the event. Please refer to Article VII, Section 13 of 2008 CPGA Tournament Rules & Regulations for Caddie Policy. Contestants are prohibited from carrying their own clubs.
