## **Background & Eligibility:**

This year's championship will be the third bearing the Jack Kelly moniker. Kelly was a PGA professional at Raceway Golf Club in Thompson, Conn., who passed away suddenly in 1994 at a young age. He was a champion of junior golf throughout his brief career. Raceway Golf Club started the Jack Kelly Junior Tournament in his honor and conducted the tournament for 10 years, from 1995 through 2004. The tournament was one of the founding events on the Connecticut Section PGA Junior Golf TOUR. Late in 2005, the section renamed this championship in honor of Kelly and also established annual Junior Golf Association Sportsmanship and leadership awards in his name.

The Jack Kelly PGA Junior Tournament of Champions also serves as the PGA Junior Golf TOUR Championship. Now in its fourteenth year, the championship invites winners of 2008 regional junior tournaments, junior club champions from the section's golf courses in Connecticut and Western Massachusetts that employ PGA Professionals, and the top 20 PGA Junior Golf Association point leaders.

Elizabeth Monty of North Granby, Conn., and Manny Tulumaris of Hartford, Conn., are the defending champions and both are among the 56 who are entered this year. Joshua Edelson (381.43 points) of Farmington, Conn., has clinched the 2008 Junior Golf Association Player of the Year title in the Boys' Division. In the Girls' Division race for Player of the Year, Katherine Partridge (511.50) of Bloomfield, Conn., holds a slight lead going into the championship, the final point tournament of the season. Following closely behind Partridge and still with a chance to win Player of the Year are Albrianna Farnum (497.50) of Mystic, Conn., Monty (495.50), and Mia Landegren (432.75) of Bridgewater, Conn.

## **Format:**

18-Holes at Stroke Play; Boys' and Girls' Divisions; sudden death playoffs for champions if necessary. Points for JGA Player of the Year will be split for ties. Spectators are welcome.

## **Prizes:**

The Champion in both the Boys' and Girls' Divisions will receive trophies.
