The Adams Golf Pro Tour Series, formerly the Tight Lies Tour, in Association with the Edgewater Sunrisers Rotary Club, are proud to announce Sartin's Vital Care Classic will be hosted at Windance Country Club in Gulfport, Mississippi, September 27-30, 2007 with a Pro Am scheduled for Wednesday, September 26, 2007.

Windance Country Club is a 6,700-yard layout with Bermuda fairways and greens which should challenge the visiting Pros. It is owned by the Island View Casino Resort that will be hosting the Pro Am Tournament.

Said Craig Sartin the sponsor of Sartin's Vital Care Classic: " I am very excited to again sponsor a professional golf tournament here at home on the Gulf Coast. As a local businessman and Windance member I am keenly aware of the positive impact that this tournament will have on our local community as we continue to rebuild."

Edgewater Sunrisers Rotary Club will be donating all proceeds to Make-A-Wish Foundation of Mississippi, The Nourishing Place and Rotary International.

Since 1980, the Make-A-Wish Foundation® has given hope, strength and joy to children with life-threatening medical conditions. From its humble beginnings with one boy's wish to be a police officer, it has evolved into an organization that grants a child's wish in the U.S. every 41 minutes."

Make-A-Wish determines a child's medical eligibility with the help of the treating physician. To receive a wish, the child must be diagnosed with a life-threatening medical condition – i.e., a progressive, degenerative or malignant condition that has placed the child's life in jeopardy. Once a child is found to be medically eligible, volunteers from the local area form wish teams that coordinate the wish. During the initial telephone contact, the Make-A-Wish® representative explains the purpose of the organization and the child's medical eligibility. A wish team is then assigned to visit with the child and family to determine the wish. Upon approval by the Chapter's Board of Directors, the wish team goes to work creating the magic!



Make-A-Wish Foundation of Mississippi is an immediate response agency assisting local people to live quality lives. It is available to meet urgent needs 7 days a week. The Director has a Ph.D. and Ed.D. and is an ordained minister. The Associate Director has a Ph.D. in sociology. The agency assists with utility bills, medical assistance, food and clothing as needed, and after Katrina it purchased furniture, appliances and building materials for many, many families.

Lewis, three-time PGA winner, Tim Herron and 2004 Funai Classic at Walt Disney Resort winner, Ryan Palmer.



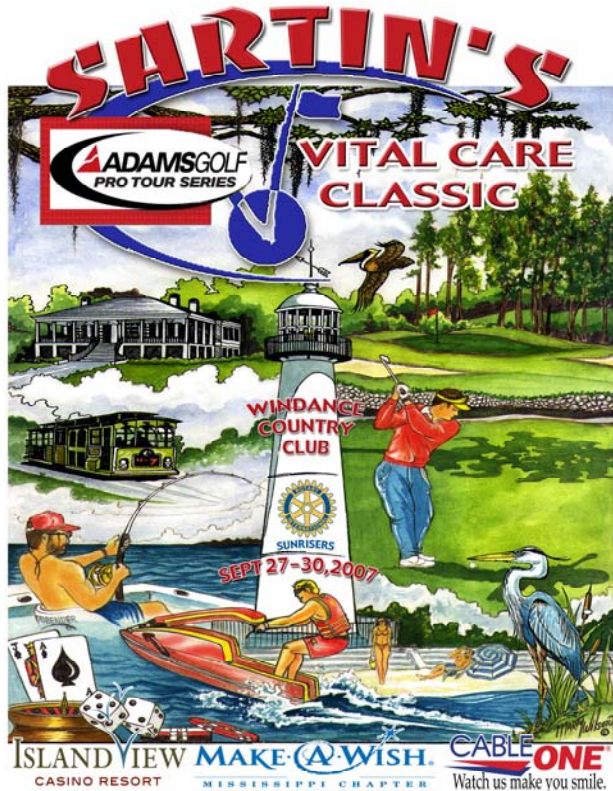
