- Colorado Section of the PGA has 27 exemptions to issue; 17 are based on their 2019 Section Points List and 10 At-Large Awardees selected by the Section.
- Colorado Golf Association has 15 exemptions to issue; these are based on their 2019 Player of the Year Points List.
- Championship host site professional.
- One returning player from the following local Division I Men's Golf teams: Air Force Academy, University of Colorado, Colorado State University, University of Denver, University of Northern Colorado and the University of Wyoming. The Head Coach of each program will determine the player.
- Sponsor Exemptions: Up to 13 exemptions may be granted.
- Committee Exemptions: A number of exemptions, including 1 for a Rocky Mountain Athletic Conference player, may be granted. Entry form and completed exemption application must be submitted to the COGF office.
- 2019 CoBank Colorado Senior Open Champion.

Playoff

Championship - Hole-by-hole playoff on hole #18 and continuing on #18 until the Champion is determined.

Low Amateur - Hole-by-hole playoff on hole #10 and continuing on #10 until the Low Amateur is determined.

Prizes

- \$250,000 purse (includes Amateur prize payouts).
- All professionals that complete the final round of play receive a minimum of \$600.
- All amateurs that complete the final round of play receive a gift certificate worth a minimum of \$175.

The Champion Receives

- \$100,000 and trophy
- A 25 year exemption from qualifying for future CoBank Colorado Open Championships

The Low Amateur Receives

- \$750 gift certificate
- The Dave Nelson Trophy
