- Sponsor Exemption: Up to 15 exemptions may be granted.
- Committee Exemption: A number of exemptions may be granted. Entry form **AND** completed exemption application must be submitted to the COGF office.

### Playoff

**Championship** - Hole-by-hole playoff on hole #18 and continuing on #18 until the Champion is determined.

**Low Amateur** - Hole-by-hole playoff on hole #10 and continuing on #10 until the Low Amateur is determined.

### Prizes

- \$250,000 purse (includes Amateur prize payouts)
- All professionals that complete the final round of play receive a minimum of \$600

### The Champion Receives

- \$100,000 and trophy
- 25 year exemption from qualifying for future Inspirato Colorado Open Championships
