

# 2017 Boy & Girls Player of the Year

## Criteria:

- \* Must have a minimal of **10 stroke\* play rounds** recorded in the JGANC from 1-1-17 to 8-28-17
- \* Must be a JGANC Member in good standing. (no shows)
- \* Weighted categories that are used to determine POY

### **Category 1: 50% Scoring Average**

- 1<sup>st</sup> in Scoring Average 20 pts
- 2<sup>nd</sup> in Scoring Average 15 pts
- 3<sup>rd</sup> in Scoring Average 10 pts
- 4<sup>th</sup> in Scoring Average 5 pts

### **Category 2: 30% Team Points from 1/1/17 to 8/28/17**

Total Team Points x 30%

### **Category 3: 20% Average Points Per Tourney**

Points will be awarded based on a players finish in JGANC Stroke play events.

#### JGANC Premier Points Event

- 1<sup>st</sup> place (10 pts)
- 2<sup>nd</sup> place thru 3<sup>rd</sup> place (6 pts)
- 4<sup>th</sup> place thru 5<sup>th</sup> place (4 pts)

#### JGANC Non Premier Points Event

- 1<sup>st</sup> place (5 pts)
- 2<sup>nd</sup> place thru 3<sup>rd</sup> place (3 pts)
- 4<sup>th</sup> place thru 5<sup>th</sup> place (2 pts)

Points will then be added up and divided by the number of events played.  
So if a player has played in 12 stroke play events and has accumulated 45 pts  
 $45 \text{ divided by } 12 = 3.75 \text{ points per event.}$

**The Player that has accumulated the most points after all points are added from each category will be considered POY.**

**\*Match Play rounds do not count. However, the stroke play round that qualifies in the the match play do count. For example, the first day of the JGANC Match Play Championship and the SF Junior is a stroke play round, only this stroke play round of these 2 events count towards the 10 required.**
