### ELIGIBLITY

#### Effective January 1, 2023

- Class A female Minnesota PGA members in good standing.

- A player cannot earn MNPGA Women's Player of the Year points without participating or posting a score for that event.

[1] Assuming at least four (4) women players are in the field. If less, no points will be awarded.

[2] If a player enters the Women's Match Play Championship as an associate, that player will only be eligible for prorated Player of the Year points if the players earn their PGA Class A membership during the event. These prorated Player of the Year points will be equal to the finishing place of the player, less any points the player earned as an associate from previous rounds. For example, a player finished runner-up in the event but earned her Class A membership during the eligible for 50 points (75 [runner up] – 25 [elite eight] = 50).
