Event #2

The top one-third of the field receives points. The position in the field that represents the lower end of the top third receives two (2) points. The next place ahead receives four (4) points, then six (6), etc. The winner will receive the appropriate number of points plus five (5) bonus points.

The top one-half of the field receives points. The position in the field that represents the lower end of the top half receives two (2) points. The next place ahead receives four (4) points, then six (6), etc. The winner will receive the appropriate number of points plus five (5) bonus points.

ELIGIBILITY
<b>Effective January 1, 2023</b>
- Class A Minnesota PGA members in good standing.
- A player cannot earn MNPGA Professional Player of the Year points without participating or posting a score for that event.

- [1] If a player qualifies for the State Open Championship as an associate, that player will be eligible for full State Open Player of the Year points if the player is a Class A member by the start of the Championship.
- [2] Point distribution is assuming at least 60 players are in the field. If less, point totals will be adjusted. See Exhibit G.
- [3] If a player enters the Match Play Championship as an associate, that player will only be eligible for prorated Player of the Year points if the players earn their PGA Class A membership during the event. These prorated Player of the Year points will be equal to the finishing place of the player, less any points the player earned as an associate from previous rounds. For example, a player finished in the final four of the event but earned his Class A membership during the round of 16 and prior to advancing to the elite eight. Therefore, the player will only be eligible for 40 points (70 [final four] – 20 [rd of 16] – 10 [rd of 32] = 40).
- [4] To receive these points, a player must have participated and successfully qualified in a USGA US Open Local or Sectional Qualifier.

NOTE: Each distribution level is based on the finish to the entire field. Example: An amateur wins the State Open and a PGA Member finishes second - the PGA Member would receive 244 points.

### Effective January 1, 2023

- Class A Minnesota PGA members in good standing 50 years of age or older when starting an eligible event.
- A player cannot earn MNPGE Senior Player of the Year points without participating or posting a score for that event.

[1] To receive these points, a player must have participated and successfully qualified in a USGA US Senior Open Qualifier.

NOTE: Each distribution is based on where one finishes in relation to all women in the field. For example, if a male wins the Section Professional Championship but a female finishes second, the female will receive first place points.

## ELIGIBILITY

### Effective January 1, 2023

- Class A female Minnesota PGA members in good standing.
- A player cannot earn MNPGA Women's Player of the Year points without participating or posting a score for that event.

**[1]** Assuming at least four (4) women players are in the field. If less, no points will be awarded.

**[2]** If a player enters the Women's Match Play Championship as an associate, that player will only be eligible for prorated Player of the Year points if the players earn their PGA Class A membership during the event. These prorated Player of the Year points will be equal to the finishing place of the player, less any points the player earned as an associate from previous rounds. For example, a player finished runner-up in the event but earned her Class A membership during the elite eight and prior to advancing to the semifinals. Therefore, the player will only be eligible for 50 points (75 [runner up] – 25 [elite eight] = 50).
