NOTICE TO PLAYERS

Play is governed by the Rules of Golf, the 2025 NTPGA Rules of Play Card, the 2025 NTPGA Pace of Play Policy and the following Supplementary Rules of Play which apply to this golf course. NOTE: Disregard any local rules found on the golf course scorecard.

- 1. FORMAT | NATIONAL QUALIFYING SPOTS | TIES:** 36-hole individual stroke play competition. Players will be repaired according to score for the second round, with the low scores going last. The NTPGA has eight (8) qualifying spots and four (4) alternate spots into the 2026 PGA Professional Championship (provided eligibility criteria is met and maintained). NOTE: The 2024 NTPGA Player of the Year automatically receives one of the eight qualifying spots per the NTPGA Rules & Regulations. Seven (7) qualifying spots are available for this championship. In the event of a tie for first place and/or to determine the final qualifying spot(s) or alternate spot(s), a hole-by-hole playoff will commence immediately following the completion of the final round.
- 2. STARTING POINT:** For the purpose of applying Rule 5.3a, the starting point for hole #1 is defined by blue dots.
- 3. TEE MARKERS:** All **MALE** contestants shall play from the NTPGA BLACK tee markers. All **FEMALE** contestants shall play from the NTPGA BLUE tee markers.
- 4. OUT OF BOUNDS:** Defined by (a) the outside edge of the perimeter paved path left on hole #6, (b) the wooden split rail fencing and brick wall left of hole #17, and (c) the maintenance facility surrounded by fencing left of hole #17.
- 5. AERATION HOLES ON PUTTING GREENS:** Areas of aeration holes on putting greens (mostly located around the edges of the green) are ground under repair even if not marked. If the aerified areas interfere with the lie, area of intended swing, or line of play (only when the ball is on the putting green), the player may take relief under Rule 16.1b (ball lies in the general area) or 16.1d (ball lies on the putting green). NOTE: Interference does not exist if the aeration holes only interfere with the player's stance.
- 6. RED PENALTY AREA WITH OPPOSITE SIDE RELIEF OPTION:** None. See Item 2(b) on the 2025 NTPGA Rules of Play Card.
- 7. CART PATH EDGES DEFINE RED PENALTY AREA:** Where red penalty areas tie into the edge of the cart path, defined by red stakes with blue tops, the edge (penalty area side) of the path defines the edge of the red penalty areas on holes #1, #2, #3, #4, #6, #7, #8, #9, #13, #14, #15, #16, #17, and #18.
- 8. TREE WELLS | MULCH:** No relief without penalty from tree wells. Mulch is a loose impediment.
- 9. IMMOVABLE OBSTRUCTIONS:** (a) Gravel areas attached to cart paths and pathways, (b) grass covered sprinkler heads, and (c) old wood "fence" posts.
- 10. TEMPORARY IMMOVABLE OBSTRUCTIONS (TIO):** Include tents and championship signage.
- 11. PACE OF PLAY:** 4 hours and 20 minutes. Please see posted NTPGA Pace of Play Guidelines (available on starting tee).

GENERAL INFORMATION

LIVE SCORING | SCORECARDS | SCORING AREA: All professionals will use the NTPGA app to live score another player in their group during each round of the championship. Scorecards must be signed, attested and returned to the scoring area immediately upon the completion of play for posting. The scoring area is located near #18 green. A player's scorecard has been returned to the Committee 15 minutes after the last player in each group exits defined scoring area (defined by blue dots).

LUNCH: Complimentary lunch for all professionals and sponsors of the event will be available on Monday ONLY. All players will order lunch off the menu at the Lounge by TopGolf located in the PGA District.

STRACKALINE HOLE LOCATION SHEET: Each side of a complete square on the green represents five (5) yards. The selection of hole locations is intended to be "balanced" for each round. With Strackaline, the nearest edge of the green as the hole is intended to be played has been identified on the hole location sheet.

SKINS GAME: All professionals will be eligible for the \$1,500 Skins Game. The \$1,500 Skins Game money will be allocated as follows; \$750 for round one and \$750 for round two. If no skins are won during round one, the skins money allocated for round one will be carried over to round two. If no skins are won during round two, the skins money allocated for round two will be added to the overall purse payout for the championship.

PLAYER'S POOL: All professionals for round two of the championship may be eligible for the Final Round Player's Pool of up to \$1,500. The eight (8) lowest round two scores will be awarded Final Round Players Pool money. NOTE: A professional who earns championship prize money is **not eligible** to earn Final Round Player's Pool money.

RESTROOMS | COMFORT STATIONS: Restrooms are located at #5 tee, #8 green, #12 tee, #15 tee, #17 tee, and at the golf shop. The code is 2468*. Comfort stations are located at #1 tee, #6 tee, #10 tee, and #15 tee.
