



Conditions of Eligibility, Selection and Qualification

Inaugural Women's PGA Cup Barton Creek, Texas, USA, 24-26 October 2019



Eligibility

The 2019 GB&I Women's PGA Cup Team consists of a team of 5 WPGA Members and will be determined on placings at the 2018 & 2019 Women's PGA Professional Championships (4 places), and one Captains Pick (1 place).

Only those WPGA Members who meet the eligibility criteria of the Women's PGA Professional Championship shall be eligible to compete at the Women's PGA Cup, that is those who hold Class AA, AAT, A, AT and those Life and Honorary Members who satisfy the criteria for AA or A membership.

Women's PGA Professional Championship

Points are allocated to the leading ten players in the Championship each year. In the event of a tie for any position other than first place, points will be split equally amongst those players. The top **four** players in the two year points table automatically qualify for the team providing the individuals meet the criteria for entry to the Women's PGA Professional Championship at all times.

Points allocation will be as follows over the 2 year qualifying period:

In the event that a player(s) holding points after the 2018 Women's PGA Professional Championship subsequently becomes ineligible for the 2019 Women's PGA Professional Championship, they will be removed from the points table and their points **will not** be redistributed.

In the event of a tie for the final place in the two year points table a 'hole by hole' play-off will be held to determine team places. This play-off will take place following the conclusion of the 2019 Women's PGA Professional Championship.

Captains Pick

The WPGA Committee will select one eligible player of their choice to play in the Team.

In the event of a player being unable to compete or withdrawing from the 2019 PGA Cup for any reason including ineligibility **following the conclusion** of the 2019 Women's PGA Professional Championship, the WPGA Committee will replace that player with an eligible player of their choice. Such a withdrawal must be made in writing to the Head of Tournaments and is not reversible.
