

ELIGIBILITY REQUIREMENTS FOR 2022 WSGA CHAMPIONSHIPS



The following is information that any person desiring to participate in a WSGA conducted Championship MUST be aware of prior to entering and/or participating. It is the responsibility of each participant to know the rules and policies that govern all WSGA competitions.

Entries are open to all amateur golfers with a WSGA/USGA Handicap Index that does not exceed the maximum posted on the tournament website, who are active members (i.e., members of or affiliated with a WSGA member club), who meet established eligibility requirements for the respective championship and meet either the Wisconsin Connection Eligibility or the Commitment Eligibility requirements as defined below. **The WSGA reserves the right to accept or reject any entry.**

CONNECTION ELIGIBILITY REQUIREMENT

In the current calendar year, the player has met one (1) of the following:

- 1) The player is a resident in Wisconsin
- 2) The player owns or leases a dwelling located in Wisconsin
- 3) The player's principle place of employment is in Wisconsin
- 4) The player has a driver's license issued by the state of Wisconsin
- 5) The player is a student who attends or did attend a high school or college/university located in Wisconsin
- 6) The player is a student who attends or did attend a high school or college/university in another state, but has maintained his/her permanent residency in Wisconsin
- 7) The player is a graduate of a high school or college/university located in Wisconsin

COMMITMENT ELIGIBILITY REQUIREMENT

In the current calendar year, the player has not played in any other state's (or USGA Allied Golf Association's) multi-day amateur championship and commits to the WSGA that for the remainder of the current calendar year, the player will not play in any other state's (or USGA Allied Golf Association's) multi-day amateur championships.
