

MEN'S SENIOR AMATEUR POINTS SYSTEM

Players earn points through listed WSGA and USGA competitions, as well as allied associations (WPGA, WPLA & WGA) and other listed state competitions. Points are used to determine the Player of the Year and exemptions into state championships. Points are not awarded after qualifying (Exception: US Open Local qualifying). Rather, only when a player actually starts the championship. Seniors can also earn points from Men's Amateur Point System (overall).
