	7. The committee has the right to change a person's flight upon entry or anytime after 36 holes of play.			
	8. The use of mobile phones on the course are not permitted by players during the round.			
	9. Approved USGA devices that measure or gauge distance only will be allowed during the tournament.			
	10. Metal and metallic spikes will not be allowed on the course during competition.

DIVISIONS :	The Men's competition will have two (2) Divisions - Men's Open (professionals and amateurs with an index up to 4.6), and Men's A-Flight (up to 7.9). Within the Men's competition there are three (3) flights - Professional, Men's Championship, and Men's A-Flight. <u>After 36 holes, each flight will be cut to approximately 50% plus ties.</u> The tournament champion will be from the Men's Open Division.			
	The Women's competition will have one (1) Division - <b>Women's Open</b> (professionals and amateurs with an index up to 10.0) - a minimum of twelve (12) entries are required to open this division. Within the Women's Open there are two (2) flights - Women's Professional and Women's Amateur - a minimum of three (3) entries are required to open each respective flight. After 36 holes, each flight will be cut to approximately 25% plus ties and/or eight strokes from the lead score.			
	The Men's Senior competition will have one (1) Division - Men's Senior Open (professionals and amateurs with an index up to 6.5). Within the Men's Senior Open competition there are two (2) flights - Professional and Amateur. All entries MUST be age 50 or older by <b>December 13, 2013</b> . After 36 holes, each flight will be cut to approximately 50% plus ties for each respective flight. Senior Professionals and Senior Amateurs will be paired together each day.
