



General Information:

- The BC Juvenile Championships are open to players age 16 and younger as of August 1st of the current calendar year.
- The Juvenile Boys' is a 54-hole gross stroke play event with no cut, based on 2017 field size.
- The Juvenile Girl's is also 54-hole gross stroke play event with no cut, based on 2017 field size.
- The Juvenile Zone Team competition is held over the first two days of the championship. Zone teams are made up of 3-4 players, with scoring based on best 3 scores on each day of the competition.
- Best-Ball Competition. Players may make up their own 2-person teams from the field. Teams wishing to participate must identify themselves before play begins on day 1. There will be a sign up sheet at registration. This championship is a best ball conducted over 54 holes.

August 15th

- 11:00 am Player Registration/Mandatory Players' Meeting
- 1:00 pm Practice Round (shotgun start) holes assigned at registration
- Players' welcome BBQ sponsored by Save on Foods prior to practice round (available after player registers)

August 16th – 18th

- 54 holes of stroke play
- Lunch provided at end of each round (ticket picked up at scoring)

- Scores will be posted directly to your Golf Canada Score Centre

- 2018 BC Juvenile Championship to be contested at Gallagher's Canyon in Kelowna date to be confirmed
