FIELD / FORMAT Western Carolinas Open – limited to the first 60 players, 36-hole stroke-play. Match Play Qualifier – 18-hole stroke-play qualifier. The 15 low scores will advance to the Match Play Championship May 6th-7th at The Country Club of Sapphire Valley. The 2018 MCPGA Match Play Champion is exempt and will be the #1 seed. If there is a tie for the final qualifying position, a sudden-death playoff will be held.

ENTRY DEADLINE Entries must be received via BlueGolf (or signup form below) by 5:00 pm on Friday, March 29th. Telephone entries will not be accepted. For questions regarding the event please call Parker Reeves – Tournament Director – at (704) 754-6336.

HOST / PRACTICE This year’s host Professional is Jason Akel, PGA. Catawba Country Club is located at 1154 Country Club Road, Newton, NC 28658. Practice rounds will be available Monday-Thursday the week prior to the event. Please call Catawba Country Club - (828) 294-3727 - to make arrangements. Player is responsible for \$25 Practice Round fee.

MEASURING DEVICES Distance-measuring devices are approved for all tournament rounds and any qualifying rounds. Measuring devices that are used must only measure distance. Any device that has the ability to measure anything other than distance (i.e. wind, gradient, or direction) is not permitted, even if the function is not used or disabled. The penalty for breach of this Rule is DQ.

DRESS CODE All contestants are required to dress in a manner in keeping with the tradition of the game. Men are not permitted to wear shorts. Dress code applies to practice rounds, and all tournament rounds.

CADDIES Caddies are permitted for tournament rounds. Contestants may also use a golf cart, but there will be a limit of two (2) carts per group. There is no discount of fees for any contestant not using a golf cart. Contestants may carry their own clubs, but are required to keep in line with pace of play policies.
