

# The Eagle Orchid Scottish Masters Wednesday 23<sup>rd</sup> - Friday 25<sup>th</sup> June 2021 Additional Local Rules - Montrose Golf Links

In addition to the provisions of the 2021 PGAEPT Tournament Rules Card and the R&A Rules of Golf **only,** the following shall apply

## 1) Out of Bounds (Rule 18.1)

- a) On or over the white line and adjoining white stakes or boundary fences.
- b) Beyond the kerbstone bordering the property behind the 18<sup>th</sup> green.

# 2) Abnormal Course Conditions (Rule 16)

GROUND UNDER REPAIR

• Any area bounded by a white line.

### IMMOVABLE OBSTRUCTIONS

a) All artificially surfaced roads and paths **except** the road behind the green on hole 18 (see below).

#### INTEGRAL PARTS OF THE COURSE

- a) The road behind 18<sup>th</sup> green as marked.
- b) All natural paths

### 3) Temporary Immovable Obstructions

- a) Hole 3 For the tee board and attached banners on the 4<sup>th</sup> tee, relief for physical interference or intervention may be taken either side of the TIO.
- b) Hole 18 Tournament Vehicle and scoreboard. Relief may be taken for intervention on either side of the TIO.

## 4) Rulings (Rule 20.1)

If a competitor is doubtful of the correct procedure during a hole, and a PGA Official is not available, he may without penalty, complete the hole with two balls. Before taking further action, the competitor should announce to his marker or fellow competitor that he intends to play two balls and which ball he wishes to count if the Rules permit. The competitor <u>must</u> report the facts of the situation to a PGA Official before returning his score card. If he fails to do so he will be disqualified.

# 6) Preferred Lies

When a player's ball lies in a part of the general area cut to fairway height or less, the player may take relief once by placing the original ball or another ball in the following relief area:

- Reference Point: Spot of the original ball
- Size of Relief Area Measured from Reference Point: Six inches
- Limits on Location of Relief Area:
  - Must not be nearer the hole than the reference point, and must be in the general area
