GIVE PLAYERS SCORECARDS. TELL THEM TO INTRODUCE THEMSELVES AND EXCHANGE SCORECARDS. VERIFY VERBALLY ON THE NEXT TEE BOX AFTER EVERY HOLE.

BOYS 12-18/GIRLS 14-18 WILL PLAY 18-HOLES
BOYS 11 & UNDER / GIRLS 13 & UNDER WILL PLAY 9-HOLES

TEE MARKERS: **Boys 16-18 will play the BLACK Tees.**
 Boys 14-15 will play the GOLD Tees.
 Boys 12-13 will play the WHITE Tees.
 Boys 11 & under and all Girls will play the GRAY Tees.

Ball will be played down.

All no mow areas, unless marked otherwise, will be played as Red Penalty Areas.

Please play two balls under Rule 20.1c (3) if you don't know how to proceed. Player must announce which ball they want to count, if not announced first ball played will be chosen by default. Player must report facts to committee if not they will be disqualified.

PLEASE TAKE GOOD CARE OF THE COURSE – REPAIR BALL MARKS! LEAVE FACILITY IN BETTER CONDITION THAN YOU STARTED.

PLEASE REMEMBER TO HIT A PROVISIONAL BALL FOR ANY SHOT THAT IS OUT OF BOUNDS OR THAT IS POTENTIALLY LOST. NO ONE SHOULD WALK BACK TO HIT ANOTHER SHOT DUE TO LOST BALL.

PACE OF PLAY – PLEASE KEEP WITH THE GROUP AHEAD. LIMIT PRACTICE SWINGS, BE READY TO GO WHEN YOUR TURN. .

HIT PROVISIONALS FOR POTENTIAL LOST BALLS AND OUT OF BOUNDS.

PERSONAL MEASURING DEVICES – ARE ALLOWED, MUST BE USED FOR DISTANCE ONLY

PLEASE STOP AT THE SAME AREA WHERE YOU CHECKED IN TO REVIEW YOUR SCORES AND DROP THEM IN THE BOX. YOU WILL VERBALLY SHARE WHAT YOU HAVE LISTED ON YOUR SCORECARD WITH MARKER. ONCE CONFIRMED, PLACE SCORECARD IN BOX AND SCORES STAND AND CANNOT BE CHANGED.

LUNCH IS PROVIDED BEFORE, DURING OR AFTER YOUR ROUND INSIDE. IT IS A HOTDOG OR BRAT, BAG OF CHIPS AND A BOTTLED DRINK.

SPECTATORS –PLEASE STAY EVEN WITH GROUP AT LEAST 30 YARDS AWAY, MAY HELP LOOK FOR GOLF BALLS, CARRY WATER, UMBRELLAS, ETC.

IN CASE OF BAD WEATHER – 1 LONG HORN BLAST MEANS DISCONTINUE PLAY IMMEDIATELY – MARK IF NEAR BALL AND HEAD IN. PLAYERS MAY RIDE IN WITH THEIR SPECTATOR AND/OR A TOURNAMENT OFFICIAL. PLEASE GO TO YOUR VEHICLE AND WAIT FOR ADDITIONAL INSTRUCTIONS. IF YOU DO NOT HAVE A VEHICLE, PLEASE SEE A TOURNAMENT OFFICIAL ON WHERE TO GO TO WAIT OUT THE STORM. YOU MAY BE ASKED TO LEAVE IMMEDIATELY, SO BE PREPARED TO BE PICKED UP.
