MICHIGAN SECTION EVENT POLICIES & PROCEDURES MICHIGAN PGA CHAMPIONSHIP

Below are a set of Policies & Procedures that the MPGA Staff have generated for the Michigan PGA Championship.

Schedule of Events / PNC Qualifying

- We have 105 players in the field
- 103 players are eligible to advance to the Professional National Championship. All Life Members and Life Member Actives are not eligible to advance
- The low 9 golfers will earn spots to the 2025 PGA Professional National Championship at PGA Golf Club in Port St Lucie on April 27-30, 2025
- Scott Hebert & Jeff Roth are exempt
- This year's winner will receive the exemption into the 2025 Rocket Mortgage Classic
- The field will be cut to the low 60 and ties after Round 2

Starting Times

- Starting times on Monday and Tuesday will range from :
 - 7:30am – 1:30pm off Hole #1
 - 7:30am – 1:30pm off Hole #1
- The field will be cut to the low 60 and ties after Tuesday
- Starting times on Wednesday will range from
 - 8:00am – 11:30am off #1

Practice Rounds

- Practice rounds will be available, please call the golf shop to book : 269-927-4653
- **The course has set a block of times from 12:00pm – 4:00pm on Sunday, please still call and book a time ,rate is \$50**
- **Please note the first tee will close at 4:00pm on Sunday**

Golf Car Policies & Procedures

- This event is riding only – no walking
- Max of 2 carts per group and 2 people to a cart
- If the player has the open seat they can have their caddie ride

- Caddies can hop on the back

Spectators & Caddies

- Caddies and Spectators are permitted. Caddie and Cart procedures are listed above.
- Spectators will be held to the same social distancing guidelines as the players
- Spectator Carts will not be available
- Handicap carts will be available on a very limited basis as players will have priority on the carts

Registration / Practice Facilities

- There will not be registration for the event
- Driving ranges will be available 1 hour prior to the participants tee time
- The driving range will stay open 30 minutes after the last group finishes for the day on Monday and Tuesday

At the First Tee / Live Scoring

- We ask that all players download the Michigan PGA App. We will be asking one player in each group to input the scores for the group.
- For those that need an updated picture for Live Scoring we can do this at the completion of your first round

Food & Beverage

- The halfway house after holes #6 and #9 on the golf course will be open
- The clubhouse will be open for breakfast snacks and for lunch
- The clubhouse bar will be open in the afternoon / evening
- Water will be provided for the players on the 1st and 10th tees

Scoring

- Once the round is complete the players will report to the scoring tent that will be located by the clubhouse
- Players will keep actual scorecards and sign and exchange them at scoring
- We will be asking one player in each group to input the scores via the blue golf app.

Post Round

- All tournament results will be available on our section website as well as the Blue Golf App as soon as the competition is completed.

Playoffs

- There will be a sudden death playoff at the conclusion of play on Wednesday for first place only, the 9 qualifying spots and the 5 alternates
