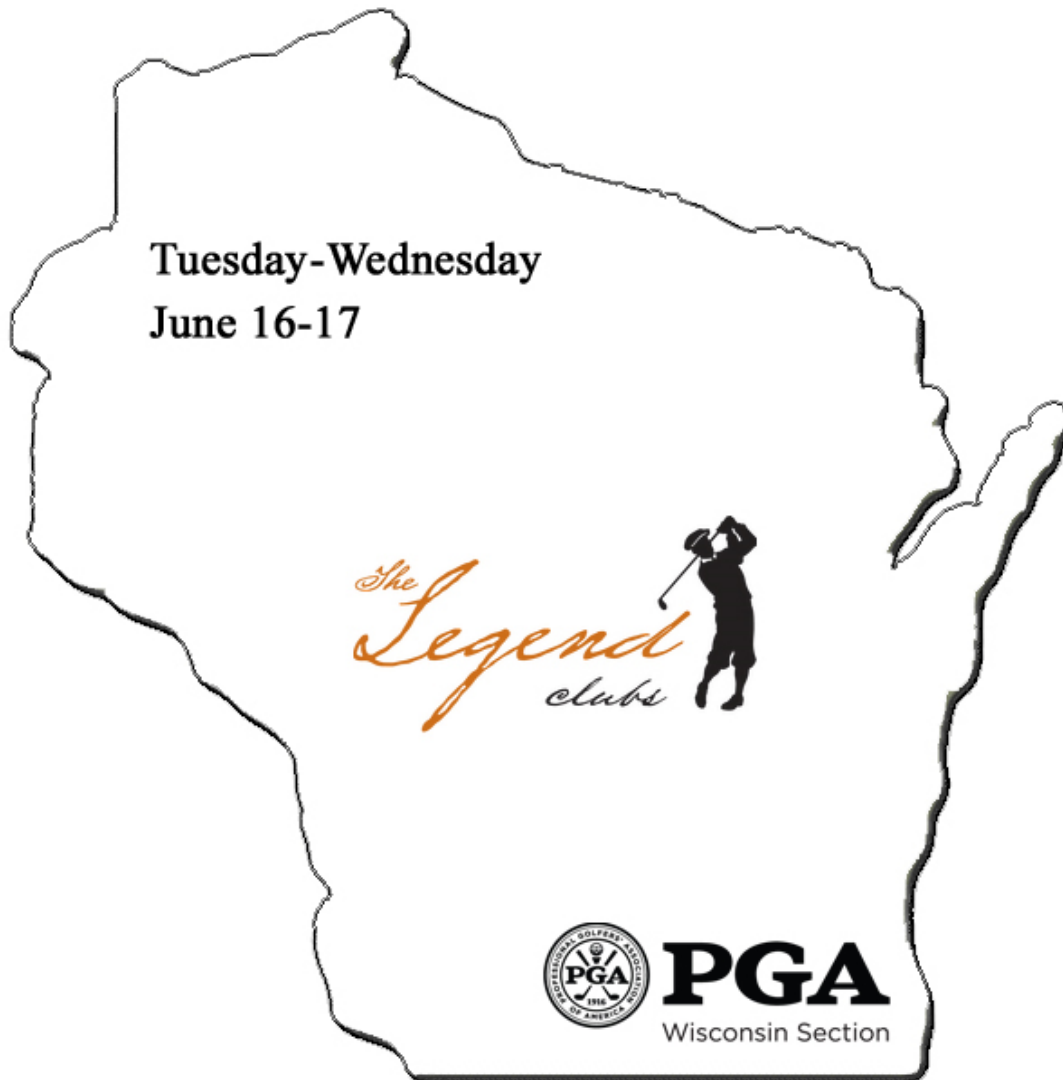


2020 WISCONSIN STATE WOMEN'S OPEN GOLF CHAMPIONSHIP

The Wisconsin State Women's Open will accept entries from players that meet the following guidelines.

WOMEN AMATEUR GOLFERS

ELIGIBILITY – Player must fit into one of the four residency categories

- 1) Are a legal resident of the state of Wisconsin.
- 2) Graduate of a high school or postsecondary school within the boundaries of the state of Wisconsin.
- 3) Presently enrolled at a postsecondary school within the boundaries of the state of Wisconsin. This clause includes incoming freshmen students.
- 4) Is a member of a club within the Wisconsin Section, PGA boundaries.

HANDICAP RULE

- 1) Player must have a USGA handicap index of 12.0 or less as of June 7, 2020.

WOMEN PROFESSIONAL GOLFERS

ELIGIBILITY – Player must fit into one of the five residency categories

- 1) Are a legal resident of the state of Wisconsin.
- 2) Graduate of a high school or postsecondary school within the boundaries of the state of Wisconsin.
- 3) Presently enrolled at a postsecondary school within the boundaries of the state of Wisconsin.
- 4) At one time resided within the state of Wisconsin.
- 5) Are working as a golf professional in the Wisconsin Section, PGA.

TOURNAMENT REGULATIONS

1. PRACTICE ROUNDS AND TOURNAMENT PROPER - CONDUCT UNBECOMING OF A PLAYER:

Any conduct that shows disrespect for the tournament committee, tournament regulations, or the traditional etiquette of golf, shall constitute grounds for disciplinary action and could result in disqualification.

- 2. DRESS CODE:** By signing your entry form, you agree to conform to the PGA Dress Code. "Proper golfing attire must be worn at all times during the tournament proper rounds. The Tournament Chairperson or duly appointed staff may prohibit play by those who do not conform to dress standards as established by the Wisconsin PGA." This is interpreted to mean that the wearing of jeans, cut off shorts, tee shirts or anything of that nature WILL NOT be permitted. Golf shorts and skorts are part of the acceptable attire. The dress code applies to contestants and caddies.

- 3. GOLF CARS, CADDIES OR WALKING:** Contestants may use a golf car, a caddie, a push cart (with or without a caddie), or carry their own bag. **ONLY PLAYERS ARE ALLOWED TO RIDE IN THE GOLF CARS, NO SPECTATORS OR CADDIES.**

Two golf cars per group maximum. At the discretion of the host facility a limited number of spectator carts for disabled / handicapped individuals may be allowed. Please inquire with the course for availability and cost.

- 4. REFUNDS:** No refunds will be given after the registration deadline. If a player withdraws before the deadline, a \$15 processing fee will be assessed by the Wisconsin PGA.
- 5. DISCLAIMER:** The disclaimer must be signed or entry will not be accepted. By registering online at wisconsin.pga.com you agree to accept the disclaimer.
- 6. REGISTRATION DEADLINE:** June 7, 2020 by 11:59 p.m. or the first 72 paid entries. Entry deadline means complete, acceptable entry. American Express, MasterCard, Visa or Discover will be accepted via online registration. To register online go to wisconsin.pga.com and go to the WPGA Tournament Schedule to select the Wisconsin State Women's Open.
- 7. NO METAL SPIKES:** All WPGA affiliated events are non-metal spike tournaments.
- 8. FORFEITURE OF AMATEUR STATUS:** An amateur may declare herself a golf professional and play as such provided she signs a letter of intent and pays the additional entry fee PRIOR to beginning play in the tournament proper.
- 9. REJECTED ENTRIES:** The Wisconsin PGA reserves the right to reject any entry due to non-competitive past performances.

NO TEE TIME REQUESTS WILL BE HONORED.

RELEASE OF LIABILITY - YOUR LEGAL RIGHTS WILL BE GIVEN UP. READ CAREFULLY AND COMPLETELY!

"I recognize there are inherent risks of physical injury and death (such as being struck by errant golf balls, slipping due to the use of shoes without metal spikes, tripping on unforeseen obstacles, being struck by lightning) in the event in which I plan to participate and that I must use caution to protect myself." Accordingly, I AGREE TO RELEASE, DISCHARGE AND COVENANT NOT TO SUE THE LEGEND CLUBS, THE LEGEND AT BRANDYBROOK, THE WISCONSIN STATE WOMEN'S OPEN OR THE WISCONSIN SECTION OF THE PROFESSIONAL GOLFERS ASSOCIATION FROM OR FOR ANY INJURY, CAUSES OF ACTION OR DAMAGES OF ANY TYPE THAT I MAY SUFFER OR THAT MAY ACCRUE TO ME OR MY ESTATE ARISING OUT OF OR IN CONNECTION WITH THE EVENT IN WHICH I WILL PARTICIPATE. HOWEVER, I DO NOT RELEASE, DISCHARGE OR COVENANT NOT TO SUE FOR ANY CLAIM OR INJURY TO THE EXTENT IT IS CAUSED BY THE RECKLESS CONDUCT OR INTENTIONAL WRONGDOING OF ANY PARTY OTHERWISE RELEASED ABOVE.

I ALSO GIVE THE WISCONSIN SECTION, PGA PERMISSION TO USE ANY PHOTOGRAPHY OR VIDEO TAKEN DURING THE PLAYING OF THE EVENT, TO BE USED FOR PROMOTIONAL OR EVENT RELATED PURPOSES.

I HAVE READ THIS AGREEMENT THOROUGHLY AND UNDERSTAND IT. I ENTER INTO THIS AGREEMENT VOLUNTARILY. IF I DO NOT SIGN THIS AGREEMENT BUT WISH TO PARTICIPATE IN THE EVENT, I AGREE TO BARGAIN FOR DIFFERENT TERMS AND WILL PROPOSE SUCH TERMS TO THE EVENT BEFORE PARTICIPATING. SUCH ADDITIONAL TERMS WILL BE REDUCED TO WRITING. IF I PROPOSE ADDITIONAL TERMS I RECOGNIZE I MAY BE REQUESTED TO PAY AN ENHANCED FEE OR PROVIDE EVIDENCE OF INSURANCE.
