ELIGIBILITY

The Suter Ward Group at Morgan Stanley Wisconsin State Open will accept entries from all exempt players, and individuals attempting to qualify that meet one of the following eligibility categories,

ELIGIBILITY – Player must fit into one of the six residency categories

- 1) Legal Resident of Wisconsin.
- 2) Wisconsin Section, PGA Member, Associate or Pre-Associate.
- 3) Golf Professional working as such on a full-time basis within the state of Wisconsin.
- 4) Graduate of a high school or postsecondary school within the boundaries of the state of Wisconsin.
- 5) Presently enrolled at a postsecondary school within the boundaries of the state of Wisconsin. Includes incoming freshmen.
- 6) An individual working on a full-time basis in the golf business and residing in the state of Wisconsin for a minimum of three months during the calendar year. Under this clause the individual must be employed and residing in the State during the dates of the tournament.

Also take note of the following in regard to eligibility,

- Players may be required to provide documentation to prove eligibility. This could include a tax return, driver's license, utility bills, diploma, paystub or housing lease.
- Players having just moved to the state must have resided in the state since June 1 of the calendar year of the championship. However, the State Open tournament committee reserves the right to make exceptions on a case by case basis for PGA members and associates that move to the state after June 1.

QUALIFYING ENTRY FEE STRUCTURE

Amateur - \$140Awaiting Amateur Reinstatement - \$140PGA Affiliated Professional - \$140Unaffiliated Professional - \$210

Qualifying fee includes golf, golf car and range. The onsite fee that used to be collected on the day of is now included in the qualifying entry fee.

All championship qualifiers will subsequently pay the Wisconsin PGA \$85 as an amateur, \$110 as a PGA affiliated professional, or \$190 as an unaffiliated professional to complete the entry fee upon qualifying. The remaining balance will be due after the qualifier has been completed. Players will receive an email requesting that they complete payment.

Players may participate in only one of the seven qualifying sites.

However, In addition - A last chance qualifier will also be conducted. It will take place on Monday, August 9 at Brown Deer Park GC. It will be open to all players, regardless if someone already tried to qualify. Registration will open on Tuesday, August 3 and close on Thursday, August 5.

TOURNAMENT REGULATIONS

- 1. **ALTERNATES:** Rotation system posted at qualifying site and on State Open webpage.
- 2. **CELL PHONE & MUSIC POLICY**: The following acts will be a violation of the cell phone and music policy that has been put in place under the event's Code of Conduct. a) The playing of music during the round b) The ringing, vibrating or production of sound effects from a cell phone c) Talking on a cell phone.
- 3. **CONDUCT UNBECOMING OF A PLAYER PRACTICE ROUNDS AND TOURNAMENT PROPER**: Any conduct that shows disrespect for the tournament committee, tournament regulations, or the traditional etiquette of golf, shall constitute grounds for disciplinary action and could result in disqualification.
- 4. **DRESS CODE**: By signing your entry form, you agree to conform to the PGA Dress Code. "Proper golfing attire must be worn at all times during the tournament proper rounds. The Tournament Chairperson or duly appointed staff may prohibit play by those who do not conform to dress standards as established by the Wisconsin PGA."

Male Contestants: Proper attire may consist of Bermuda shorts or dress trousers, and a golf shirt. The wearing of jeans, cargo shorts, athletic shorts, cut off shorts, tank tops, tee shirts or anything of that nature WILL NOT be permitted.

Female Contestants: Proper attire may consist of golf shorts, skorts or dress trousers, and a golf shirt. The wearing of jeans, cargo shorts, athletic shorts, cut off shorts, tank tops, tee shirts or anything of that nature WILL NOT be permitted.

All Caddies: Proper attire may consist of Bermuda shorts or dress trousers, and a golf shirt. The wearing of jeans, cargo shorts, athletic shorts, cut off shorts, tank tops, tee shirts or anything of that nature WILL NOT be permitted.

- 5. **ELECTRONIC SCORING**: Official scoring will be done via the Wisconsin PGA app. Each player will electronic score for a fellow competitor on their phone. Scoring codes will be sent out on the morning of the event. Paper scorecards will be provided as an additional way to track your own score. At the conclusion of the round each group should report to the scoring table to verbally confirm their scores with a WPGA staff member.
- 6. **FORFEITURE OF AMATEUR STATUS**: An amateur may declare himself a golf professional and play as such provided she signs a letter of intent and pays the additional entry fee PRIOR to beginning play in the tournament proper.

7. GOLF CARS, WALKING AND CADDIES:

- Contestants may ride in a golf car or walk. Caddies, push carts (with or without a caddie) and carrying your own bag is allowed.
- Golf car fees are included in the entry fee.
- Golf cars will be set up for two riders per car. Maximum two golf cars per group.
- Only Players are allowed to ride in the golf cars, no spectators or caddies (Includes spectator carts). Penalty for breach of this rule can be found in the Code of Conduct policy online.
- If a player wants they may request a single golf car but an additional fee will be required (\$45 per day for an additional golf car). This request must be submitted at least a week in advance of the event or qualifier by emailing Chris Hoel at <u>choel@pgahq.com</u>.
- At the discretion of the host facility a limited number of spectator carts for disabled / handicapped individuals may be allowed. Please inquire with the course for availability and cost.
- 8. **NO METAL SPIKES**: All WPGA affiliated events are non-metal spike tournaments.
- 9. **PRACTICE ROUND INFORMATION:** Rates and availability will be posted to the Wisconsin PGA website.
- 10. **RAIN:** The State Open Committee will decide the procedure of play in the event of a rain delay or other circumstances during the event.
- 11. **REFUNDS**: If a player (exempt or qualifier) withdraws before their assigned registration deadline, a \$20 processing fee will be assessed by the Wisconsin PGA. No refunds will be given for players attempting to qualify after the registration deadline for the qualifier they are registered for. Exempt players withdrawing in between July 12 and August 1 will be given a refund of half their entry fee.
- 12. **REGISTRATION DEADLINE**: Qualifiers #1, 2 Sunday, July 4 at 11:59 PM. Exempt Entries or Qualifiers #3 thru 7 Sunday, July 11 at 11:59 PM. Online registration at <u>wisconsin.pga.com</u> will be accepted with an American Express, MasterCard, Visa or Discover card. To register for a qualifier select one of the "Qualifying Sites", if you are exempt select the event titled "The Suter Ward Group at Morgan Stanley Wisconsin State Open"

- 13. **REJECTED ENTRIES**: The Wisconsin PGA reserves the right to reject any entry due to non-competitive past performances.
- 14. **SLOW PLAY WILL NOT BE TOLERATED:** Penalties will be assessed if necessary.
- 15. **TEE TIMES**: Will be posted on <u>wisconsin.pga.com</u> and emailed out to all players. Tee times will start at 7:30 a.m. on all three days.
- 16. **DISCLAIMER**: The disclaimer and release of liability must be agreed to or the entry will not be accepted. By registering online at <u>wisconsin.pga.com</u> you agree to accept the disclaimer.

DISCLAIMER & RELEASE OF LIABILITY

YOUR LEGAL RIGHTS WILL BE GIVEN UP. READ CAREFULLY AND COMPLETELY

"I recognize there are inherent risks of physical injury and death (such as being struck by errant golf balls, slipping due to the use of shoes without metal spikes, tripping on unforeseen obstacles, being struck by lightning) in the event in which I plan to participate and that I must use caution to protect myself." Accordingly, I agree to release, discharge and covenant not to sue the Wisconsin State Open, any of the qualifying host sites, Blackwolf Run/Kohler Golf, Pine Hills Country Club, or the Wisconsin Section of the Professional Golfers Association of America from or for any injury, causes of action or damages of any type that I may suffer or that may accrue to me or my estate arising out of or in connection with the event in which I will participate. However, I do not release, discharge or covenant not to sue for any claim or injury to the extent it is caused by the reckless conduct or intentional wrongdoing of any party otherwise released above.

I also give the Wisconsin Section, PGA permission to use any photography or video taken during the playing of the event, to be used for promotional or event related purposes.
