ELIGIBILITY

The Wisconsin State Senior Open will accept entries from amateur and professional male golfers who have attained the age of fifty (50) as of September 6, 2022 and meet the following guidelines.

MEN AMATEUR GOLFERS

ELIGIBILITY – Player must fit into one of the four residency categories

- 1) Are a legal resident of the state of Wisconsin.
- 2) Graduate of a high school or postsecondary school within the boundaries of the state of Wisconsin.
- 3) An individual that is a member of a club within the Wisconsin Section PGA boundaries. Defined as someone that has a full access membership to a club or course that provides unlimited use of their facilities. These memberships usually have a monthly or full year fee structure.
- 4) An individual working on a full-time basis in the golf business and residing in the state of Wisconsin for a minimum of three months during the calendar year. Under this clause the individual must be employed and residing in the State during the dates of the tournament.

HANDICAP RULE

Player must have a WHS handicap index of 8.0 or less as of August 25, 2022.

MEN PROFESSIONAL GOLFERS

ELIGIBILITY – Player must fit into one of the four residency categories

- 1) Are a legal resident of the state of Wisconsin.
- 2) Graduate of a high school or postsecondary school within the boundaries of the state of Wisconsin.
- 3) PGA Members, Associates or Pre-Associates that are part of the Wisconsin Section PGA.
- 4) An individual working on a full-time basis in the golf business and residing in the state of Wisconsin for a minimum of three months during the calendar year. Under this clause the individual must be employed and residing in the State during the dates of the tournament.

Amateur - \$175Awaiting Reinstatement - \$175Professional - \$200After Day One Play - Cookout Guest - \$30 (Additional & Optional)

TOURNAMENT REGULATIONS

- 1. **CELL PHONE & MUSIC POLICY**: The following acts will be a violation of the cell phone and music policy that has been put in place under the event's Code of Conduct. a) The playing of music during the round b) The ringing, vibrating or production of sound effects from a cell phone c) Talking on a cell phone.
- 2. **CONDUCT UNBECOMING OF A PLAYER PRACTICE ROUNDS AND TOURNAMENT PROPER**: Any conduct that shows disrespect for the tournament committee, tournament regulations, or the traditional etiquette of golf, shall constitute grounds for disciplinary action and could result in disqualification.
- 3. **DRESS CODE**: By signing your entry form, you agree to conform to the PGA Dress Code. "Proper golfing attire must be worn at all times during the tournament proper rounds. The Tournament Chairperson or duly appointed staff may prohibit play by those who do not conform to dress standards as established by the Wisconsin PGA."

Proper attire for contestants will consist of Bermuda length golf shorts or long dress trousers, and a golf shirt. The wearing of jeans, cargo shorts, athletic shorts, cut off shorts, tank tops, tee shirts or anything of that nature WILL NOT be permitted. The Dress Code applies to players and caddies.

- 4. **ELECTRONIC SCORING**: Official scoring will be done via the Wisconsin PGA app. Each player will electronic score for a fellow competitor on their phone. Scoring codes will be sent out on the morning of the 1st round. Paper scorecards will be provided as an additional way to track your own score. At the conclusion of the round each group should report to the scoring table to verbally confirm their scores with a WPGA staff member.
- FORFEITURE OF AMATEUR STATUS: An amateur may declare himself a golf professional and play as such provided he signs a letter of intent and pays the additional entry fee PRIOR to beginning play in the tournament proper.

6. GOLF CARS & CADDIES

- Golf car fees are included in the entry fee.
- Golf cars are mandatory and will be set up for two riders per car.
- Only Players are allowed to ride in the golf cars, no spectators or caddies (Includes spectator carts). Penalty for breach of this rule can be found in the Code of Conduct policy online.
- Caddies are allowed. If a player chooses they may walk along with their caddie, provided the player's clubs are placed on the golf car and transported by a fellow competitor.
- If a player has extenuating circumstances and requires a single golf car, they may request one by emailing Chris Hoel at choel@pgahq.com. Requests must be received at least a week in advance of the event and the player will be required to pay an additional rental fee for each round they need the single golf car. This fee could include the full cost to bring in an extra golf car.
- If carts are unavailable due to weather / course conditions, the event or round will not be played.
- At the discretion of the host facility a limited number of spectator carts for disabled / handicapped individuals may be allowed. Please inquire with the course for availability and cost.
- 7. **NO METAL SPIKES**: All WPGA affiliated events are non-metal spike tournaments.
- 8. **REFUNDS**: No refunds will be given after the registration deadline. If a player withdraws before the deadline, a \$15 processing fee will be assessed by the Wisconsin PGA.
- 9. **REGISTRATION DEADLINE**: August 25, 2022 by 11:59 p.m. or the first 104 paid entries. American Express, MasterCard, Visa or Discover will be accepted via online registration. To register online go to <u>wisconsin.pga.com</u> and go to the WPGA Tournament Schedule to select the Wisconsin State Senior Open.
- 10. **REJECTED ENTRIES**: The Wisconsin PGA reserves the right to reject any entry due to non-competitive past performances.
- 11. **TEE TIMES**: Will be posted on <u>wisconsin.pga.com</u> and emailed out to all players. Tee times will start at 10:00 a.m. on day one and at 8:30 a.m. on day two. **NO TEE TIME REQUESTS WILL BE HONORED.**
- 12. **DISCLAIMER**: The disclaimer and release of liability must be agreed to or the entry will not be accepted. By registering online at <u>wisconsin.pga.com</u> you agree to accept the disclaimer.

DISCLAIMER & RELEASE OF LIABILITY

YOUR LEGAL RIGHTS WILL BE GIVEN UP. READ CAREFULLY AND COMPLETELY

"I recognize there are inherent risks of physical injury and death (such as being struck by errant golf balls, slipping due to the use of shoes without metal spikes, tripping on unforeseen obstacles, being struck by lightning) in the event in which I plan to participate and that I must use caution to protect myself." Accordingly, I agree to release, discharge and covenant not to sue Hidden Glen GC, The Wisconsin State Senior Open, or the Wisconsin Section of the Professional Golfers Association of America from or for any injury, causes of action or damages of any type that I may suffer or that may accrue to me or my estate arising out of or in connection with the event in which I will participate.
